### Be Sure to Include:

- Pictures/Symbols
- Do not copy/paste
- Keep text brief
- Compare the US stats for the following: Economy, Population, Per Capita GDP, #Telephones, Internet Usage

- I used a large enough font to see from a distance and one that is easily read.
